

Commuting to New York from West Orange

West Orange is located approximately 15 miles west of Manhattan. Many residents commute daily into the city, most commonly to Midtown or Lower Manhattan. There are buses to the city from several locations around West Orange, as well as a **new local jitney** to take residents of the town to nearby train stations (<http://www.westorange.org/index.asp/nid=1415>, click on Route 6). Additional options are a short drive away.

PATH (Harrison Station)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Frequent subway-style service to Midtown and Lower Manhattan. Service along 6th Ave to Midtown, and to World Trade Center. 20-minute drive to Harrison, then 20 minutes to WTC or 30 minutes to midtown. 	Yes	Fastest way to Lower Manhattan, good option for Midtown East together with the subway. Frequent 24-hour service is good for irregular schedules.	http://www.pathrail.com
Community Coach #77	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Bus service to PABT. Leaves from the Codey Arena Park & Ride and several other locations in town. Express bus takes about 40 min to PABT. 	No*	More frequent service than DeCamp; some neighborhoods are closer to this bus than the DeCamp bus.	http://goo.gl/5KAmss
NJ Transit Train	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Train to NY Penn Station on NJ Transit's Morris & Essex or Montclair lines. Nearby stations include Orange, Brick Church, South Orange, Millburn, Maplewood, Bay St. and Bloomfield. Approximately 40 trains/day. 10-minute drive to Brick Church, 25-30 minutes to Penn Station on the train. 	No**	Fastest to West and Central Midtown. Orange and Brick Church stations are less than 10 minutes away by car.	http://www.njtransit.com
NJ Transit Bus #320	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Frequent service to PABT from the North Bergen Park & Ride. 30-minute drive, 20 minutes on the bus. 	Yes	More frequent service to Midtown than the train, especially midday.	http://www.njtransit.com
